Campground Rules

Check in time: 5pm, Friday, May 12th

Check out time: 12:00 noon, Sunday, May 14th

1. In the event of an emergency call 911.

If you have any emergency, please give the operator the address of the campground as well as your site number and name.

2. If there is a weather related emergency, you may tune to the local station at 100.9 for further information. The fairground bathroom facilities will be available only in the event of an emergency; however this is not a certified storm shelter. It would be available for cover, but you would do so at your own risk.

3. All campers must maintain a distance of 10 feet from the campers next to it.

This is a state law. There may be an inspector on the grounds at some point during the event and he will be looking for this.

4. Please be aware of carbon monoxide exhaust. Please make sure your generator or camper exhaust is not going directly into another unit.

5. You **MUST** be 18 years of age or accompanied by an adult in order to camp.

Anyone found to be breaking this rule will be asked to leave.

6. **DRINKING ON THE GROUNDS:** Anyone drinking alcohol on the grounds must be 21. The

Richland County Sheriff will be patrolling the area and will ticket all underage drinkers.

7. Dogs are allowed in the campgrounds. All dogs must be on a leash. If you bring a dog, clean up after it, or you will be asked to leave. Please Note: Dogs are not allowed in the seating areas!

8. Quiet time begins at midnight and goes through 6:00 a.m. If you feel this time is too late, please remember that this is **NOT** a traditional campground; therefore, peace, quiet and privacy are **NOT** likely in this setting. Please consider staying at Alana Springs Campground (608)647-2600 for a more traditional, full service campground with free shuttle to the event.

9. Campfires are allowed only to the extent that they are contained in a **raised** fire ring. **No fires are allowed on the ground.** Fire rings are not provided. Please don't start a bonfire or we will

have to put it out with any available liquid closest to the fire (including but not limited to your beer and/or cooler). The Fire Chief may ban any and all fires at his discretion depending on weather conditions or other factors.

10. ATV'S, Golf carts, and Scooters. ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUNDS! If you have a medical need for transportation, please obtain a permit from the campground hosts. If you have a prohibited motor vehicle in the campgrounds, you will be asked to leave with no refunds.

11. There is only one electric camping unit allowed per electric site.
Most sites are 20' X 40' (caution – electrical sites 11-18 are only 15' x 40')
Your camper and vehicle must fit in this space. If you have additional vehicles, they should park in general parking. There is no charge for general parking.

12. Please bring the appropriate cords and plug-ins for camping. All electric campers should have the needed adapter. If you are in a non-electric site and are running a generator, please be courteous to your neighbors.

13. There are no shower facilities available on the grounds. Bathroom facilities are by portable bathroom units only.

14. Nature's Way will be available on Sunday to pump out your camper if desired. The cost for this is \$20 (cash only). There will be a sign up at camper check-in. You will need to pay when you sign-up.

15. For your convenience there are water faucet on the fairgrounds to fill your tanks with water if needed.

16. Please be considerate of the people living in the homes along the campground areas. Please watch your behavior and your language as there are young children that live in these homes. If we continue to have a problem, we may lose the privilege of camping.

17. Refunds: No refunds are available for camping.

18. NO FIREWORKS OR FIREARMS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND.
IF YOU ARE FOUND WITH THESE, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT IMMEDIATELY WITH NO REFUNDS.

These rules are for the comfort and safety of all campers!

Please remember that we are in 20' x 40' area therefore, we are very close together and should be considerate of others.

Any and all other rules may be added or changed, as we feel necessary!
